

**Plan Commission & Community Preservation Minutes  
Town of Tilden  
10790 100<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Chippewa Falls  
July 9, 2025 at 7:00 PM**

**Meeting called to order at 7 p.m.** by Chairman, Dave Hartman.

**Roll call:** Eric Bohl, Dean Gullickson, Dan Reischel, Dave Hartman, Jackie Boos and Dawn Briskey. Not present: Dave Adams and Gary Meinen. There is a quorum. Others present: Al Goettl and Dan Adams from the Community Preservation Committee, Jeff Bowe, Kathy Shear and Mary Hartman

**Verification of public notice:** The Town Web site and at the front of the Tilden Town Hall.

**Approve Minutes:** Al Goettl moved to approve the minutes of the November 20, 2024 and seconded by Dean Gullickson. Only ayes heard in the voice vote.

**The Town of Tilden Board** asked Dave Hartman to have the plan commission meet to discuss the possibility of increasing the Levy because the price of Ambulance Service and Road Repair is going up substantially.

**Tax Levy** was reviewed for the possibility recommending the Town Board of increasing the Town Levy. Road cost have gone up substantially. It cost over \$200,000 to pave one mile. Tilden has 42 miles of road. The Department of Transportation hired Mark Servi to inspect 6' – 20' structures in the Town of Tilden. The structures were rated on a 10 (new) to 0 (failed) scale. The Department of Transportation required Mark to notify the Town when the condition state is found to be 5 or less. Five structures were rated below 5. One was rated at a 2, three were rated a 3, and One was rated at a 4.

The Township of Tilden is required to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to its residents. Tilden paid the City of Chippewa Falls \$36.60 per capita in 2024, \$45.75 per capita in 2025 and will pay \$57.19 per capita in 2026.

The current mill rate of .00121 = \$1.21 per \$1000.

Tilden will have to replace the End Loader, Fire Engine a one-ton truck in the near future, so should put more money in the outlay accounts.

Dawn Briskey made a motion to recommend the Town Board increase the Town Levy by \$100,000 to spend as to be determined by the Town Board. Dean Gullickson seconded. Only ayes heard in the voice vote.

**ATV/UTV Route on County Highway Q.** Wisconsin law allows towns to authorize ATV/UTV use on roads with a 35 mph or less speed limit within their boundaries, regardless of who has jurisdiction over the road. Jackie Boos made a Motion to recommend the Town Board to adopt Chippewa County Highway Q from 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue going South to where the 35 mph speed limit ends, which is south of Chippewa County Highway B. Eric Bohl seconded. Only ayes heard in the voice vote.

Dean Gullickson moved to adjourn and Eric Bohl seconded. Only ayes heard in the voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 8:40 P. M.
